Current Involvement Road Schemes

Telecommunications Masts

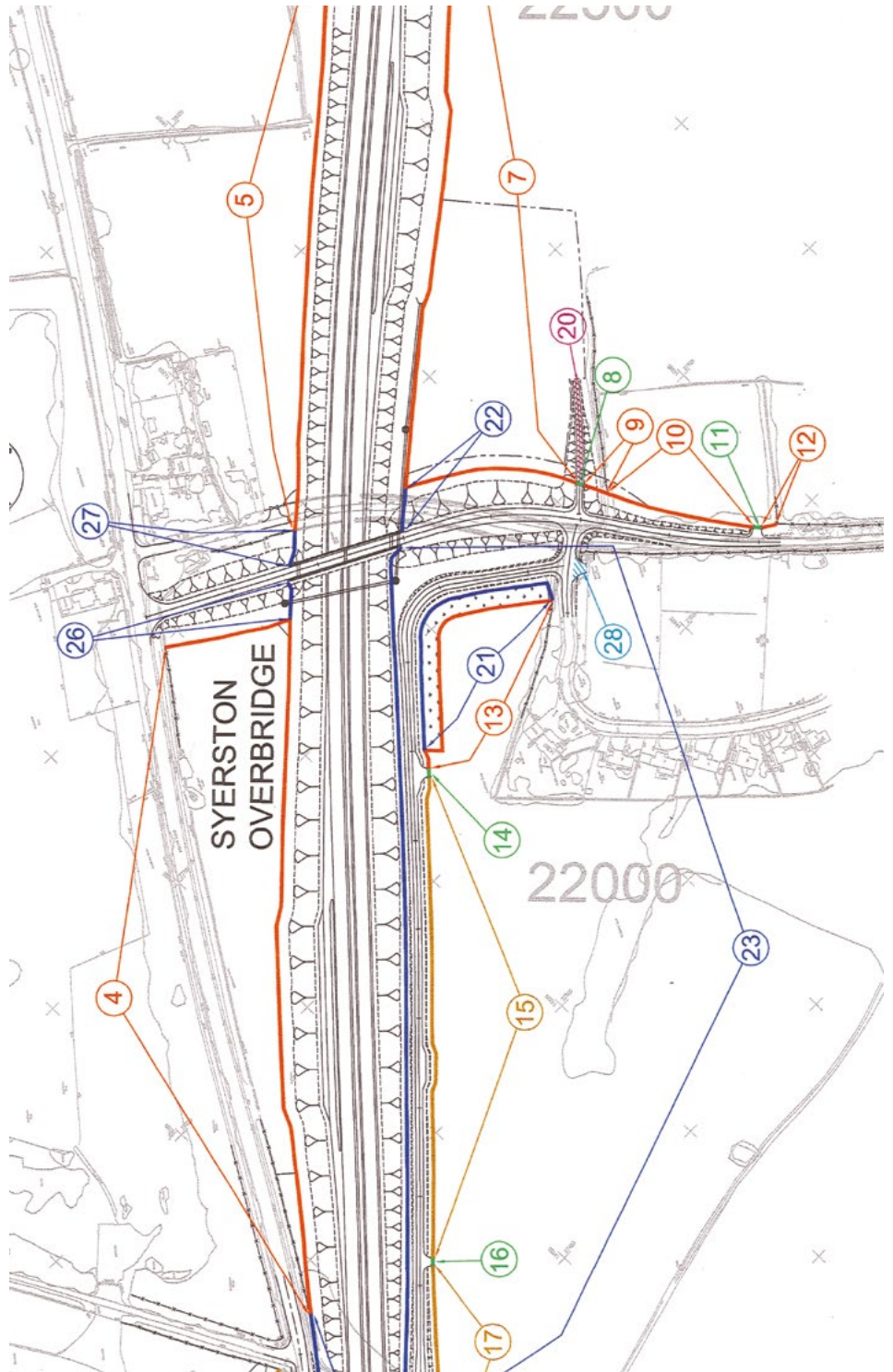

Telephone, Fibre-optic Cables & Installations

Schemes relating to the installation of underground or overhead electricity and fibre optic cables, sub-stations, poles and pylons. Advice includes negotiating routes, wayleaves and temporary or permanent easements including payments and compensation for damage to land, property and crops.
